

DRINKING FOUNTAINS

Too few available

THE scarcity of public drinking fountains, forcing people to use bottled water, is causing environmental damage, a green group says.

A study of 1000 Australians by the Bottled Water Alliance found that 79 per cent believe there are not enough drinking fountains available in cities.

Planet Ark founder and Alliance organiser John Dee said: "Public water bubblers have disappeared off the map."
